Erie Board of Trustees Action Items – February 25, 2014

The Board Considers Sunset Development Plat and Rezoning – During last night's meeting the Board considered a resolution for approval of the Preliminary Plat and a Rezoning ordinance for the Sunset Development. The Sunset property is approximately 104 acres located at the northwest corner of Weld County Road 5 and Weld County Road 6. The development has a maximum allowable limit of 265 dwelling units, with 247 units being proposed by the applicant. The Board will next consider both the resolution and ordinance during the March 11, 2014 Board of Trustees Meeting.

Board Approves Water-Wise Irrigation Programs for 2014 – The Board of Trustees approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the Center for ReSource Conservation to provide an outdoor irrigation inspection program for commercial and residential irrigation systems. The irrigation inspections are designed to pinpoint inefficiencies which contribute to water waste, unnecessary runoff, increased run-time and maintenance costs. This program meets conservation goals set by the Town of Erie's Water Conservation Plan.

Slow the Flow Irrigation Audit Program

The Town of Erie has partnered with the Center for ReSource Conservation to provide FREE sprinkler inspections to residents from June-August. During the inspection you will receive a customized watering schedule, learn do-it yourself sprinkler maintenance and be give tips on how to improve the efficiency of you sprinkler system to save water and money. Space is limited and appointments will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis. Sign up today to reserve your spot in this popular program!

Indoor Water Inspection Program

The Center for ReSource Conservation will offer an indoor water inspection program. The indoor water inspection program includes evaluation of inside water use and water fixtures in each home, and an offer to install at least two aerators and one low-flow showerhead. The inside water inspections will begin in March, end in May, then resume in September and end in December.

Water-Wise Landscape Seminar

The Center for ReSource Conservation has developed a Water-Wise Landscape Seminar. Details will be provided at a later date.

Board Approves 2014 Tree Planting Initiative Program – During the last night's meeting the Board approved this year's Tree Planting Initiative Program. The program consists of the Residential Tree Incentive Program, HOA Cost Share Program, Schools/Non-Profit Cost Share Program and the Town Tree Program. For 2014, the Residential Tree Incentive Program will have 300 certificates available on a first come, first served basis for up to \$150 toward the cost of a tree to be planted on a private residential property. This program was established in 2005 and has resulted in more than 5,000 new trees planted in Erie. To participate in this program contact the Tree Incentive Hotline at 303-926-2739.
