Erie Board of Trustees Action Items September 9, 2014

Keep Erie Safe Animated Video Wins First Place in National Competition – During Tuesday night's meeting Mayor Harris was presented with the SAVVY Award for best Promotional Video (Population: 0 - 75,000) for the Keep Erie Safe animated video about the need for a new Municipal Court and Police Building in Erie.

The Savvy Awards, held in conjunction with the [3CMA](#) annual conference, recognize outstanding local government achievements in communications, public-sector marketing and citizen-government relationships. The Savvies salute skilled and effective city, county, agency or district professionals who have creatively planned and carried out successful innovations in communications and marketing. This year, more than 600 entries in 37 categories were received.

In 2013, 3CMA awarded the "Town of Erie Economic Development Mobile Application" its highest honor, the 2013 President's Award for Most Outstanding Marketing Program in addition to two SAVVY Awards and one Silver Circle Award.

Board Approves Contract to Improve Grandview Drainage – After the 2013 storms in August and September; Town of Erie staff worked with consultants to determine improvements that would help reduce future flooding hazards affecting the Grandview Subdivision. Due to the proximity to Grandview and the cost savings, the Erie Highlands development agreement states that the developer would provide the Town a bid to have their contractor complete the Grandview drainage improvements. During Tuesday night's meeting, the Board approved a resolution with a not to exceed amount of \$57,500, which includes

a 15% contingency, for improvements to be made on Tract T which is owned and maintained by the Town of Erie. View a map of where Tract T work will be [here](#).

Board Approves Purchase and Services for Magnesium Chloride Tank – The Board of Trustees approved a resolution on Tuesday night to purchase and install a new magnesium chloride tank for \$67,000.00. Magnesium chloride is used as a deicing agent on the streets during colder temperatures. There are four parts to this project which include purchasing and installing the tank; purchasing and installing the pump to the tank; electrical upgrade to accommodate the large pump and filling the tank. It is estimated that this project will be completed by December 2014 in time for the winter storm season.
