Board to Consider Ordinance Prohibiting Recreational Marijuana Businesses – During Tuesday night's meeting, the Board of Trustees considered two options regarding the regulation of recreational marijuana businesses within the Town of Erie. The first option was an ordinance prohibiting recreational marijuana businesses and the second an ordinance extending the existing moratorium on recreational marijuana businesses through December 31, 2016. After consideration, the Board decided to move forward with consideration of the ordinance prohibiting recreational marijuana businesses during their next regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, November 10 2015.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with state law, since 2009 the Town of Erie has investigated regulations and enacted legislation concerning the operation of recreational and medical marijuana businesses within the Town of Erie.

Matt Wiederspahn, Development Engineer: Matt was responsible for reviewing the submittal documents and engineering reports for the King Soopers Marketplace including water, sewer, storm water drainage, roadways, geotechnical and traffic reports. Matt demonstrated excellent customer service by providing King Soopers with both technical and professional support to keep this project moving forward.

Todd Bjerkaas, Senior Planner: Todd was responsible for ensuring land use compliance of the King Soopers commercial development. He established effective working relationships with the property owner, other agencies and the developer to assist them through the Town's planning process.

Paula Mehle, Economic Development Coordinator: Paula served as the lead for this project and acted as Town liaison with the developers (King Soopers). Paula continues to work with the developer's brokers to market and attract appropriate end users – specifically for the pad sites – to promote the success of the Marketplace.

BACKGROUND: The STAR Award has been created to recognize and express appreciation for services rendered by Town employees who demonstrate exceptional service and/or performance in one or more of the following categories: Customer Service; Safety; Creativity; Teamwork and Outstanding Achievement.

Town Approves Preliminary Plat for Vista Ridge Filing No. 12 – The Board approved the Vista Ridge Filing No. 12 First Amendment which is comprised of three lots for multi-family residential buildings; three tracts for roads utilities and park use and one future development tract. The property, zoned PD-Planned Development, is located on the southeast corner of Ridge View Drive and Mountain View Boulevard and is approximately 18 acres in size. The applicant's site plan proposes 144 dwelling units distributed among 36 4-unit Manor Homes in Vista Ridge.
