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Update to Notice from Anadarko

Removal of Well in Baxter Farms to Occur Earlier than Initially Announced

Anadarko Petroleum Corporation has informed the Town that they will remove (plug and abandon) an existing well located in the Baxter Farms neighborhood on or around June 15, 2015. The start date is earlier than initially announced. It will take approximately four weeks to complete this work, a work over rig will be on location starting Monday, June 15, 2015. Other heavy equipment will be used and a portion of the sidewalk will be closed during this time. In an effort to reduce the impact to the surrounding community, crews will only be working on site Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. You may see a slight increase in traffic in the area, approximately 7-10 trucks per day. An Anadarko representative will be on location 24/7 throughout the operation.
