We are writing to inform you about a scheduled activity on an existing oil and natural gas well near your community. Beginning on or around May 9th, we will begin to plug and abandon a well located near your home. This activity means that we will be discontinuing oil and natural gas production from this well, removing all surface equipment and reclaiming the land back to match the existing landscape. We anticipate this activity to last approximately 2-3 weeks. This activity requires the use of a work-over rig and other heavy equipment. You can expect to see a slight increase in traffic in the area.
