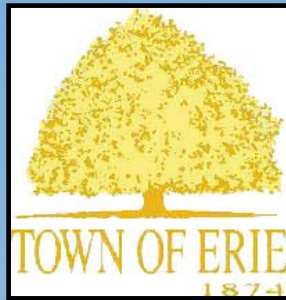


NATURAL AREAS INVENTORY
