



Town of Erie Dog Licensing Information

Dogs owned by residents in the Town of Erie must be licensed. Every owner of a dog over six months of age shall have the animal licensed within 30 days after it is brought into the Town.

Length of the license is determined by rabies vaccination expiration date.

The owner shall provide the following information:

- Proof of current rabies vaccination
- The name, physical address and telephone number of the owner of the dog
- Veterinarian proof of neuter or spay
- Microchip # if applicable
